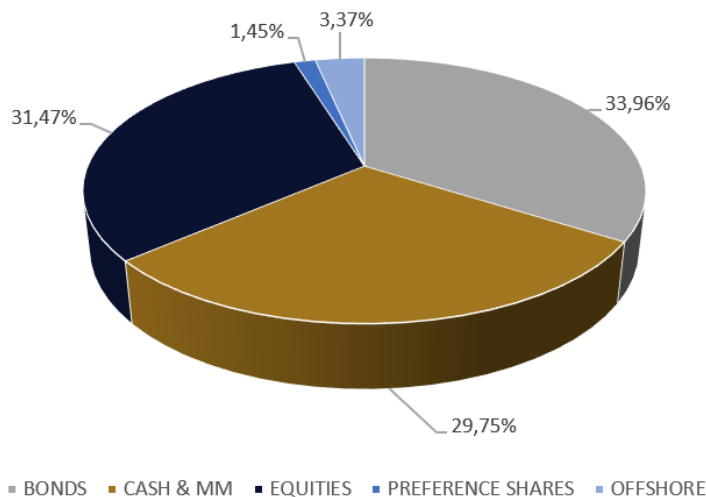

Policy Objective:

Outperform CPI+ 3% over a 3-year rolling period.

Analysis of the portfolio and information on adherence/non-adherence with policy objective:

Headlines from the Middle East continued to drive domestic and global markets in Q2. The first quarter was characterized by growing oil market disruptions and inflation concerns, investor sentiment improved in the second quarter after the US and Iran signed the Islamabad Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on 19 June. By the next week, Brent crude had fallen back to its pre-war levels (\$75 per barrel) and erased the premium seen earlier in the quarter. This came after the US issued a 60-day license allowing Iran to resume oil exports while negotiations continue and improved global oil supply.

Domestic equities fell -2.4% in the second quarter off the back of significant losses and volatility in the commodity markets. Gold declined below \$4000/oz for the first time since 2025 as market sentiment improved and demand for defensive assets moderated. The All Bond Index (ALBI) rose by +7.9% in Q2 after a slight recovery in June of +1.5%. The Rand strengthened -4.3% against the USD for the quarter, offsetting gains from falling crude prices. Nevertheless, the Rand was still one of the better-performing emerging market currencies as the SA economy was supported by relatively resilient fundamentals.

In global markets, the S&P500 grew 15.2% over the Q2 marking the index' strongest quarterly returns since 2020. The strong performance was fuelled by expectations of strong earnings-per-share (EPS) growth y-o-y.

The fund delivered a return of 2.3% for the quarter, whilst the benchmark delivered 3.2%. Thus, generating negative alpha of -0.8%.

Change made to the composition of the portfolio during the period:

No material changes to the portfolio composition. Changes that have happened are consistent to the investment philosophy & process of the fund.

Glossary Summary

Annualised performance: Annualised performance show longer term performance rescaled to a 1-year period. Annualised performance is the average return per year over the period. Actual annual figures are available to the investor on request.

Highest & Lowest return: The highest and lowest returns for any 1 year over the period since inception have been shown.

NAV: The net asset value represents the assets of a Fund less its liabilities.

Alpha: Denoted the outperformance of the fund over the benchmark.

Sharpe Ratio: The Sharpe ratio is used to indicate the excess return the portfolio delivers over the risk-free rate per unit of risk adopted by the fund.

Standard Deviation: The deviation of the return stream relative to its own average.

Max Drawdown: The maximum peak to trough loss suffered by the Fund since inception.

Max Gain: Largest increase in any single month

% Positive Month: The percentage of months since inception where the Fund has delivered positive return.

Average Duration: The weighted average duration of all the underlying interest-bearing instruments in the Fund.

Dividend Yield: The weighted average dividend yield of all the underlying equity in the Fund. The dividend yield of each company is the dividends per share divided by the price.
